## *Week One*

## Required:

1. First day with words--Teach your sort to someone else.
2. Definitions: Look up the definitions of 5 of your words and write them in your notebook.
3. Choose one from below: Complete 1 of the following assignments using as many different words as you can. Your work should be done in your word study notebook or may be printed out to be handed in on review day. (Day 5)

- Spelling Steps: Write at least 10 of your words into a step shape.
- Spelling City: Complete at least one printable activity on spellingcity.com.
- 30 Second Words: Write a TV commercial using as many words from your list.
- Story Words: Write a story using as many words as possible.


## *Week Two*

## Required:

1. Sentences: Write complete sentences for 5 of your words (in word study notebook or spellingcity.com) ${ }^{* *}$ Be sure to use capital lefters, correct punctuation, and be sure that your sentences show that you understand the meaning of the word.
2. Night before test: Do a writing sort. Have someone read each word to you as you write each one under the proper category.
3. Choose one from the list below: Complete 1 of the following assignments using as many different words as you can. Your work should be done in your word study notebook or may be printed out to be handed in on test day. (Check the team website or your assignment book for your test day date.)

- Word Hunt: Do a word hunt in a book, magazine, or newspaper. Find 3-5 words that would fit with each of your headings.
- Definitions: Look up the definitions of 5 of your words and write them in your notebook. (Do not use the same words as week 1.)
