## WhiteValue

Value: an element of art that refers to the lights and dark of an object.

**Chiaroscuro**: is a term describing the effects of light and shade in a work of art, particularly when they are strongly contrasting.

**Value Scale-** a chart that demonstrates the changing values of a tone on a scale of steps

from dark to light.

Shade with white color pencil (blend from top to bottom to create a value scale)

Shade with White charcoal (blend from top to bottom to create a value scale)
