The Preterite Tense tells what someone did, or what happened. These are its only translations. The action is completed, the time period is closed, and we see (through time limits or markers) or feel (through context) this fact.

Regular Preterite Endings

<u>-ar</u>	<u>-er, -ir</u>
-é -amos	-í -imos
-aste -asteis	-iste -isteis
-ó -aron	-ió -ieron

Conjugate correctly & give to teacher:

1. lavar

2. levantar

3. comer

4. aprender (to learn)

5. vivir

6. abrir (to open)

Additional Hints

1. one syllable verbs NEVER have accents.
2. 1st & 3rd forms (yo, él, ella, usted) always have accents (ONLY regular verbs).
3. Irregular Preterites never have accents.
