Part I

- * Research your given topic (NO WIKIPEDIA)
- * After consulting two or more sources, prepare a two paragraph (5-8 sentences per paragraph) summary of your topic.
- * Be sure to highlight at least 5 significant facts about your historical topic.
- * Record the websites you used.

Part II

- * Thinking about the survivors stories that you heard and what you have written down, prepare a written personal reflection. Use your reflection worksheet to help you write this paragraph. You should include which story had the most impact on you and why.
- * It must be one paragraph in length (5-8 sentences minimum).

Guidelines for Paper:

1. This should be one continuous paper, so try to transition from part I to part II using some sort of transitional phrase, word or sentence.
2. The paper must be typed, printed and include a works cited page.
3. Make sure to include your name.
