2. Option #1 Description & Requirements:

- ✓ Your goal is to create a website using Wix that teaches someone about the basics of HTML.
- ✓ First, pick a template and url. Format colors and fonts where necessary.
- ✓ There should be five pages or tabs. You can format the layout of each page in the pages section.
 - i. Page #1: Welcome & overview of HTML: You should have a picture as your header, paragraph description of what HTML is & how to get started creating a website, and a table or listing of basic tags. https://example.com/html/. <a href="https://example.com/html/"
 - Note: It would be cool to insert pictures of the code. You can print scr, paste image in paint, crop, and save as a picture. Use past examples.
 - ii. Page #2: How to create a basic webpage. Focus on the tags needed for content. Headers, paragraphs, bold, italic, center, bullets. Show a picture as an example with code and without code. Provide 2 links to w3schools.com to learn more at bottom.
 - iii. **Page #3**: *How to create a basic website*. Focus on these tags. Links, images, hotspot, hyperlinks. Show a picture as an example with code and without code. Provide 2 links to w3schools.com to learn more at bottom.

- iv. Page #4: *How to create a table*. Focus on these tags. Table, tr, th, td, colspan, rowspan. Show a picture as an example with code and without code. Provide 1 link to w3schools.com to learn more at bottom.
- v. **Page #5**: *CSS*: Focus on teaching about the three different styles (Inline, internal, external). Also, explain how color works. Show a picture as an example with code and without code. Provide 2 links to w3schools.com to learn more at bottom.
- vi. **BONUS**: Add a page about Forms. Focus on these tags. Form, input, and different button tags. Show a picture as an example with code and without code. Provide 1 links to w3schools.com to learn more at bottom.
- ✓ When done, save your website, copy the live url, and paste it in the submission box in Moodle.

3. Option #2 Description & Requirements:

- ✓ Your goal is to create a website from scratch that teaches someone something
 you are interested in.
- ✓ You need at least three pages that link back and forth to each other.
- ✓ Use w3schools.com or Google to find answers to any code questions you have.
- ✓ Things I want to see at least once in the website:
