A creative process that combines art with technology to communicate ideas.
What do Graphic Designers do?

Graphic designers create, choose and **organize** the elements of text, images and the so-called "white space" around them, **to communicate** a message.

Graphic designers create posters, logos, pamphlets, billboards, products, t-shirts, fonts...

• A written document that describes what the client wants. The brief contains the answers to important questions and also contains sketched ideas.
