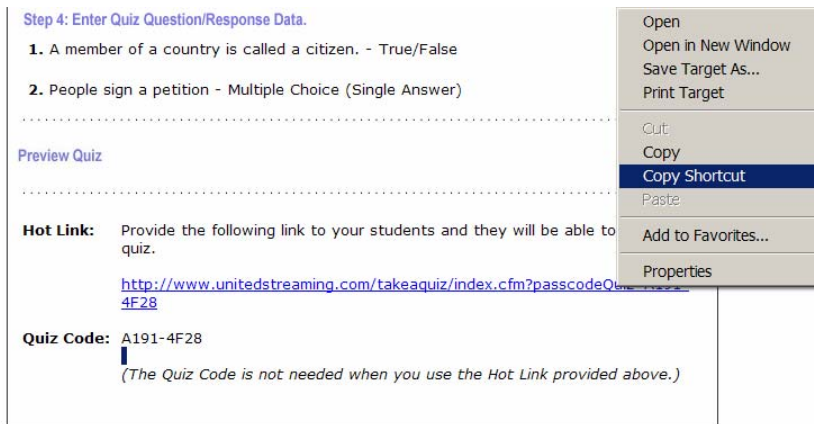
2. Click My Quizzes

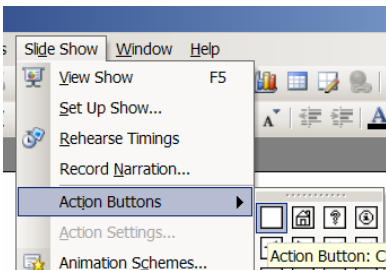
3. Click the title of the quiz you just created.

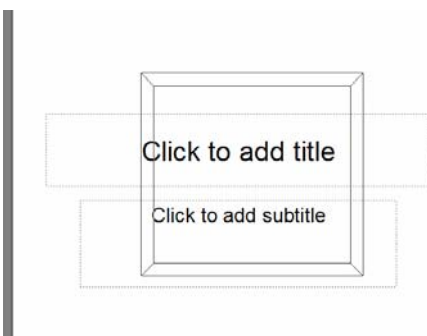
4. Scroll to the bottom of the screen where you will see a web address. Right-click the address and choose COPY SHORTCUT.



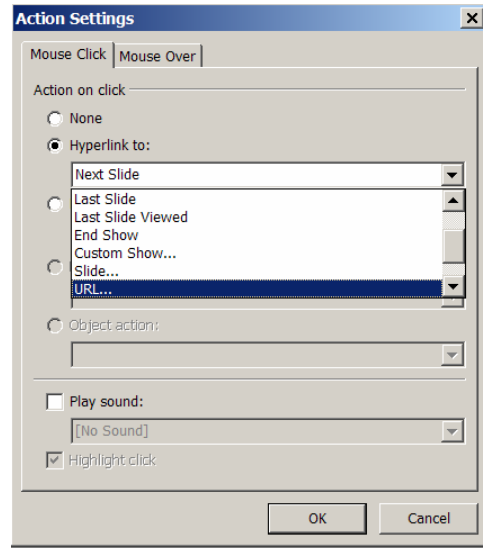
5. Open PowerPoint
6. On the first slide you will place an Action Button that will connect students to the quiz. Here's how:
 - Click Slide Show...Action Button...Choose the first button.



- Click and drag the button on the slide.



- A new window will appear when you release the mouse. Click in the **HYPERLINK TO** circle. Then click the dropdown arrow and choose URL. Click **OK**.



- You can change the button color by double-clicking it. To place text on the button, right-click the button and choose **ADD TEXT**.
