Personal Repeated Object:

Choose an interesting object to draw.

- *It must be cropped and touch at least 3 of the 4 edges of the paper.
- *It should be 4X6in or 5X5in in size.
- * The object will be drawn in contour, noting the highlights and shadows
- * You will trace the original contour drawing 6 times.
- * You will then complete each drawing using only one element in each one. (6 total drawings, one using only line, one using only texture, one using shape etc).

Line: A mark with greater length than width, can be straight (vertical,

horizontal, or diagonal), curved, wavy, zigzag, and can be thick or thin.

Shape: A closed line. Can be geometric, organic, or biomorphic. Shapes are

f!at and can be expressed in length and width.

Form: 3-dimensional, Length, width and depth.

Space: is the area between and around objects, this space is referred to as

negative space. In art Space can also refer to the illusion of depth.

Color: Light reflected off objects. Its main characteristics are Hue, The name

of the color like blue; Value, how light or dark it is; Intensity, how bright

or dull it is.

Value: differences in a hue or neutral ranging from lighted to darkest.

Texture: How something feels or is perceived to feel
